BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

Gottlieb Albrecht, the son of Samuel and Elizabeth Albrecht, was born January 16, 1855, in St. Louis County, Missouri. He died May 26, 1938, in Bonhomme Township, St. Louis County.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The collection consists primarily of deeds, title certificates, and related papers regarding Albrecht family property in U.S. surveys 415 and 1911 in Bonhomme Township, St. Louis County, Missouri. The collection also includes several promissory notes and papers relating to the estate of Samuel Albrecht.

- 1871 Nov 9 Certificate of title compiled by J.G. McClellan, 316 Chestnut St., St. Louis, Mo., for land in U.S. survey 1911 in Bonhomme Township, St. Louis County. Title is vested in Laura L. and Jas. B. Townsend. Includes annexed certificate signed L. Babcock, March 14, 1863, that he has examined the title to a tract of land in Bonhomme Township, St. Louis County, and that he has found the title vested in Benjamin F. Townsend, now deceased.
- 1874 Feb 24 Certificate of title compiled by J.G. McClellan, St. Louis, Mo., for land in Bonhomme Township, St. Louis County, owned by Laura L. and James B. Townsend.
- 1880 Jan 7 Tax deed for property in Bonhomme Township, St. Louis County, Missouri, assessed to Benjamin F. Townsend's estate, and sold for delinquent taxes to Joseph A. Berry. The property was, in turn, sold to Charles W. Caines.
- 1880 Sept 28 Tax deed for land in U.S. surveys 415 and 1911 in Bonhomme Township, St. Louis County, Missouri, assessed for tax to the Benjamin F. Townsend estate, sold to Charles W. Caines.
- 1881 Apr 13 Document signed Adam Fick and Lesetta Fick [or Lisetta Fick]. "Received of Samuel Albrecht of St. Louis County, my father in law, eight hundred dollars, being the purchase money for the S.E. 1/4 of N.W. of Section 25 S. 45 R 3 – and do hereby acknowledge this amount to form a part of the estate of my aforesaid father in law whenever he may depart this life, and that this amount shall be considered as an advancement made to my wife out of her share in such estate but this shall donation shall otherwise not be considered a lien against my or my wifes estate or property."
- 1881 Apr 14 Indenture between Elizabeth Mertz and Samuel M. Fisher, leasing to Fisher a house and land at Hill Town, Bellefontaine Post Office, St. Louis County, Mo. Land was formerly occupied by Henry W. Mertz, deceased. Elizabeth Mertz was his widow.
- 1881 June 24 Deed for sale of land in Bonhomme Township, St. Louis County, Missouri, of Mary A. Charles (widow) and Frank T. Charles (bachelor) to Emil L. Dosenbach.
- 1881 July 21 True copy of the original summons in the St. Louis County circuit court in the case of Samuel M. Fisher, administrator of the estate of Henry W. Mertz, deceased, Elizabeth Mertz, Adelia Mertz, Josephine Mertz, Daniel Mertz, and Albert Mertz, defendants, and Elizabeth Schnarr and her husband, Henry Schnarr, plaintiffs.
- 1881 Dec 1 Deed of sale of land sold by Charles W. Caines of St. Louis County, Missouri, to Emil L. Dosenbach of St. Louis County. Land is located in surveys 415 and 1911

in Bonhomme Township, St. Louis County.

- 1882 July 11 Certificate of title of Emil L. Dosenbach's farm, a tract of 178 acres in U.S. surveys 1911 and 415, St. Louis County, Mo., compiled by C. Th. Uhlmann, investigator of titles to real estate, St. Louis, Mo., at the request of Mr. S. Albrecht. (15 pages)
- 1888 Nov 9 Letters of administration of the St. Louis County Probate Court appointing Gottlieb Albrecht administrator of the estate of Samuel Albrecht.
- 1889 Nov 13 Account regarding the settlement of the estate of Samuel Albrecht.

- 1889 Dec 24 Typescript agreement between Gottlieb Albrecht; Caroline Kram and her husband, Herman Kram; George August Albrecht; Ernst T. - 1890 June 2 Typescript deed for sale of several parcels of real estate of John Albrecht (a minor) by Charles Eisenhardt, curator of his estate, to Gottlieb Albrecht, George August Albrecht, and Ernst T. Albrecht. Deed was executed per order of the St. Louis County probate court. Others mentioned in the document include Ludwig Sahm, Herman Schaeper, and Joseph Riegert (appraisers); Samuel Albrecht and his daughter Lisetta Fick; Andrew J.L. Stevens; Richard H. Stevens; Frederick Hyatt; Henry Weinrich; J. Cunningham; Stephen Lanham and his daughters Pamela Lanham, Nancy Lanham, and Virginia Lanham; Emil L. Dosenbach; and Miranda Fenn.
- 1892 Aug 12 Deed of trust between Gottlieb Albrecht and his wife, Elizzbeth Albrecht, parties of the first part, John F. Kessler, party of the second part, and Louis Kessler, party of the third part, for the sale of land in U.S. surveys 415 and 1911 in St. Louis County.
- 1892 Aug 12 Promissory note signed Gottlieb Albrecht, promising to pay Louis Kessler \$75. Stamped "cancelled, Aug. 12, 1895, Frederick Essen, recorder."
- 1892 Aug 12 Promissory note signed Gottlieb Albrecht and Elizzbeth Albrecht, promising to pay Louis Kessler \$1500.
- 1895 Apr 11 Promissory note signed Gottlieb Albrecht, Richmond, Ind., promising to pay Gaar, Scott & Co. \$1350. Stamped "paid, Sep 4, 1895, Franklin Bank, St. Louis, Mo."

- 1895 Aug 29 Certificate of title of property of Gottlieb Albrecht located in U.S. surveys 415 and 1911 in St. Louis County.
- 1895 Aug 31 Promissory note signed Gottlieb Albrecht, St. Louis, Mo. Verso includes notes regarding interest payments.
- 1895 Sept 9 Declaration signed Joseph Craighead, vice-president of Gaar, Scott & Co. of Richmond, Indiana, stating that the chattel mortgage of Gottlieb Albrecht with Gaar, Scott & Co. has been fully paid.
- 1895 Sept 17 Note of Moses P. Johnson Machinery Co., 715-717 North 2nd Street, St. Louis, to Gottlieb Albrecht, Bellefontaine, Mo. "Enclosed find your cancelled note and chattle mortgage. We sent the mortgage to the factory for them to cancell. . . ."
- Circa 1902 Financial statements and receipts of Miss Lizzie Albrecht with the Missouri Baptist Sanitarium, 909 Taylor Avenue, St. Louis. (19 documents)

Agreement notarized January 3, 1918, and filed with the St. Louis County recorder January 28, 1918.
