Mrs. M.M. Hayes resided in Paducah, Kentucky, in the early 1900s.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The collection includes advertising material of the Hy-Mol Drug Co. (St. Louis, Missouri), the National Toilet Co. (Paris, Tennessee), and The Lanola Co. (Paducah, Kentucky). A couple of these items are addressed to Mrs. M.M. Hayes of Paducah, Kentucky.

- Circa 1890 Circular of the Lambert Pharmacol Company, St. Louis, promoting Listerine.
- 19– Virginia Pharmacy stock certificate, Dyersburg, Tennessee.
- Circa 1905 Circular of the National Toilet Co., Paris, Tennessee, titled “Directions for Using Satinola.” Satinola was a skin-care product. Circular includes a brief testimonial of Mrs. L.T. Sullivan, Whiteville, Tennessee.
- 1905 Feb 21 Typescript letter of the National Toilet Co., Paris, Tennessee, to Mrs. M.M. Hayes, Paducah, Kentucky.
- 1905 Mar 13 Typescript letter of Dr. Charles Company, manufacturers and sole proprietors of Dr. Charles’ flesh food, the great flesh former and beautifier, New York, to Mrs. M. Hayes, Paducah, Kentucky.
- 1905 Apr 14 Typescript note of the Western Bottle Manufacturing Co., Chicago, to the Shoffner-Hayes Medicine Co., Paducah, Kentucky.
- No date Two handwritten brochures of the Hy-Mol Drug Co., St. Louis.
- No date Proposition of the Hy-Mol Drug Co., St. Louis, to agents and mail order men. Provides instructions for selling Hy-Mol tooth paste. Also includes advertisement for the Rexx Coin Carrier.
