SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

Collection contains receipts, programs, invitations, business cards, and photocopies of newspaper clippings mostly relating to St. Louis.

- 1873 May 18 Letter signed T.J. Capel to Mrs. Mackay. Invites her to lunch in Chelsea. Letter is written on stationery of Cedar Villa, Wrights Lane, Kensington W.
- 1884 May 17 Program for the first anniversary of Hickory Council No. 766, Royal Arcanum, at Becker's Hall, northwest corner McNair Ave. and Victor St. Performers include Mr. P. Deckelmann, Geo. H. Fischer [George H. Fischer], Miss Josie J. Bush, Mr. G. Hansen, Louis A. Steber, Mr. F. Feinemann, Miss M. Steber, Miss R. Steber, Mr. F. Lindemuth, and Mr. C. Bumüller.
