BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

Anton Hoefle (1850-1915), a native of New Jersey, married Caroline (or Kate) Scholl (1858-1926), a native of Missouri and daughter of John Scholl. Anton and Kate's son Charles died February 13, 1909, at age 27. John Scholl had another daughter named Ida Scholl (or Ida Showles).

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The collection includes family correspondence, photographs, and other papers of the Hoefle-Scholl family of St. Louis and New Jersey. Includes correspondence of Miss Ida Showles of Long Branch, New Jersey.

- 1908 Nov 23 Postcard of reception room, Evang, Deaconess Hospital, St. Louis, Missouri. Postcard signed Charley Hoefle to Miss Ida Showles, Long Branch, New Jersey. "I am at the Hospital again & doing fine. Will be home for Thanksgiving. Hope you are well."
- 1909 Feb 13 Letter signed "Brother Charles," St. Louis. (The letter does not include the recipient's name.) Briefly describes Charlie's death. Letter is written on stationery of the Laclede Hotel, which includes an engraved image of the hotel.
- 1909 Mar 1 Unsigned letter to "Dear Aunt, Uncle and Ida." Discusses the death of "Charlie" following an operation.
- 1924 Aug 27 Letter signed Ida Showles, Long Branch, New Jersey, to "Dear Friends." Thanks her friends for the enjoyable day, and invites Floyd to visit her.
- 1925 Sept 3 Letter signed Aunt Ida [Miss Ida Showles], Long Branch, New Jersey, to "Dear Floyd." Invites him to visit her.
- 1932 Dec 22 Christmas card of Aunt Ida to Floyd Hoefle, Sewall, New Jersey, care of Ruddick. Card is enclosed in envelope of the Long Branch Banking Co., Long Branch, New Jersey.
- 1942 July 25 Letter signed Alice to "Dear Freda & Family." Provides requested information for obtaining Floyd's birth certificate. Mentions the deaths of Edgar and Uncle Lee and that Buford (Hannah's son) is now married.
- 1967 June 15 Typescript letter of Kathi to her parents, Mr. & Mrs. Ben W. Mealey, Woodbury, New Jersey. Thanks her parents for the graduation gift of a typewriter. Also thanks her parents for all they have done for her.
- No date Business card of William Hoefle, 4001 N. Florissant Ave., alderman, 2nd Ward, St. Louis, Missouri.
- No date Card: "Vote for Charles Scholl, Democratic candidate for city register. Subject to the Democratic Primaries to be held Friday, March 7th." Includes photograph of Scholl.
- No date Photograph of Charles Scholl and friend attending Shriners Convention in Atlantic City.
- No date Two portrait photographs of unidentified young woman. Portrait by Hutchinson, East St. Louis, Illinois.
- No date Portrait photograph of Charles Hoefle (father of Floyd Hoefle), St. Louis, Missouri.
