- 1868 May 14 Deed for sale of land in Jefferson County, Missouri, of the Jefferson County sheriff to Thomas Mathews. This land had been seized from Robert Mathews since he had not paid alimony to Sarah Mathews.
- 1868 Feb 21 Receipt of the collector of Jefferson County, Missouri, to Thos. W. Matthews [Thomas W. Matthews] for real and personal property taxes for land in Jefferson County.
- 1869 May 12 Quietus for delinquent taxes of the State and County Collector's Office, Jefferson County, Missouri, to Thos. Matthews [Thomas Matthews], who has paid his taxes on property in Jefferson County.
- 1876 Jan 17 Quietus for taxes on land of the State and County Collector's Office, Hillsboro, Jefferson County, Missouri, to Thos. Matthews [Thomas Matthews], who has paid his taxes on property in Jefferson County.

- 1957 Pages from Kimmswick homecoming booklet, including brief history of Kimmswick by Hazel Wells Diard and several business advertisements.
- 1958 Mar 1 Program for award dinner of the Kimmswick, Mo., Planned Progress Program. The following men and women are listed in the program: Rev. James J. Franey, Mary Ann Baltz, Mrs. Rodney Alexander, Marion Diard, Mayor Ray D. Cagle, Betty Losh, Barbara Scott, H.R. Scott, Phyllis Kauffmann, Sandra Hickam, and Rev. Lawrence D. Woodcock.
- 1958 Apr 23 Letter signed Ruth Alexander (Mrs. Rodney Alexander) to Mr. van Ravenswaay. Discusses upcoming tour of Kimmswick and historic sites in Jefferson County. Mentions Carl Feiss, Theodore Kim, Prof. Bolgar, Miss Cecelia Lauschenbach, Mrs. Jessie Bristol (nee Waters), Mrs. Hazel Diard, and Marion Diard.
- 1958 Jan 22 *Naborhood News* (Lemay, Mo.) newspaper clipping titled "Kimmswick receives \$1000 Progress Award."
- 1974 Mar 3 *St. Louis Post-Dispatch* newspaper clipping titled "\$65,000,000 Project for Jefferson County." Describes Parkton project, a planned community development in north Jefferson County.
- no date Photocopy of incomplete *Festus News Democrat* article titled "County Should Restore Its Historical Treasures." Discusses the work of Mrs. Rodney Alexander and Mrs. Irma Herrell in cleaning up neglected cemeteries. Mentions the uncovered grave of Friederich W. Ziegler, born December 26, 1823; died January 11, 1865.
