SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

Collection consists primarily of programs for events in St. Louis and advertising material for St. Louis businesses.

- 1901 July 1 Teachers second grade certificate awarded to Miss Eda Feldner, signed by A.E. Hinners, county superintendent, Cass County, Illinois.
- 1919 Booklet titled "Pevely's Baby Beauties," published by Pevely Dairy Company, St. Louis. Includes portraits of 21 babies with the baby's name and age, parents' names and address, and a note from the mother promoting the use of Pevely milk. Also includes a photograph of the Pevely Dairy barns (63 pages). Includes return postcard of Pevely Dairy Company that includes an illustration of the company's building at Grand and Gravois Aves.
- 1921 Mar 28 Program for the annual assembly ball of the St. Louis General Assembly, Fourth Degree, Knights of Columbus, at Arcadia, St. Louis, Mo. Includes greeting, lists of committee members, program of dances, and donor list. (13 pages)
- 1931 May Issue of *The Joint Council of Women's Auxiliaries Bulletin*, Volume V, Number 59. (20 pages)
- 1934 Jan 30 Menu and speakers list for President Roosevelt's birthday party at the Hotel Coronado. Verso reads, "Your presence here tonight graciously contributes to a humane project that is close to the heart of our beloved President Franklin Delano Roosevelt. It is to establish through the direct help of the citizens of the country and endowment fund for the Georgia Warm Springs Foundation, created in 1926 by President Roosevelt, so that this Foundation may carry on its national crusade against Infantile Paralysis. . . ."
- 1934 Feb 12 Program for the twelfth annual Lincoln birthday dinner dance and bridge, presented by the Traffic Club of St. Louis, Hotel Statler, St. Louis, Mo. Includes the menu, program, and lists of board and committee members.
- 1938 Apr 30 Program for the Tenth Annual Endowment and Student Aid Party, held under the auspices of the Alumni Association of the School of Commerce and Finance, St. Louis University. Includes lists of officers, board of directors, committee members, and supporters. (9 pages)
- 1941 Apr 13 Booklet of the dedication of the Calvary Cemetery chapel and mausoleum. Includes an illustration, description, the archbishop's sermon, and the names of the officers of the association. (7 pages)
- No date Advertising card of South Side National Company, investment division of South Side National Bank.
- No date Printed notice of Quick Meal Stove Company, 825 Chouteau Ave., St. Louis, Missouri, titled "To the Purchaser of This Range." Vouches for the quality of the Quick Meal Range and its Lorain Oven Heat Regulator.

- No date Booklet of the National Pet Supply Co., St. Louis, Mo., titled "Mrs. Halfin's Care and Treatment of Cage Birds." (12 pages)
- no date Season's greetings card of Mayor Bernard F. Dickmann. Includes a night-time photograph of St. Louis City Hall.
- No date Advertising card of Ernest H. Steinhauser, 3939 West Florissant, St. Louis, Mo., recommending Hartshorn shade cloths.
- No date Circular of Bretscher's the Safe Drug Store, Linton and West Florissant Aves.
- No date Circular of M.W. Warren Coke Co., distributors, St. Louis, Mo., providing instructions on how to burn coke. "Help the smoke abatement cause."
- No date Circular of Meehan Electrical Appliance Co., 3623 Gravois Avenue, St. Louis, Mo., promoting the Savage washer and dryer. Includes illustrations of women using the appliances. **(oversize)**
