BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Joseph W. Walsh died September 23, 1842, in St. Louis. His daughter, Margaret J. Walsh, married John E. Yore. John E. Yore (1831-1867) died July 1, 1867, in St. Louis. Margaret J. Yore died October 31, 1912, in St. Louis, at the age of 71.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The collection contains deeds and other land papers of the Walsh-Yore family of St. Louis, Missouri.

1825 Aug 13 Certificate of the Office of the Recorder of Land Titles in the State of Missouri confirming the claim of Louis Constant under Gabriel Constant, Sr., to a lot in the Carondelet common field.

Folder 2

1836 Nov 14 Deed of sale of property in Illinois City, St. Clair County, Illinois, from Victoire Laflambe Ruelle, widow of Joseph Ruelle, late of St. Louis, Missouri, to Joseph W. Walsh of St. Louis. This property had been conveyed to Joseph Ruelle by Jesse B. Thomas, John Hay, John Hays, Nicholas Jarrot, and Francis Turcotte in 1820. Filed in the St. Louis County deed books, January 12, 1878.

1840 Jan 23 Deed of sale of property in St. Louis city block 53 from Patrick Walsh and his wife, Margaret Walsh, both of St. Louis, Missouri, to James B. Walsh of St. Louis. Recorded by John Ruland, clerk of the St. Louis County circuit court and ex-officio recorder, March 12, 1840.

1856 Dec 31 Deed of sale of property in Lee County, Iowa, from Margaret J. Walsh of St. Louis, Missouri, to James E. Bruce, of Keokuk, Iowa, and John S. Thomson of St. Louis. Notarized by Edmund P. Walsh, St. Louis, March 31, 1858, and certified by R. McFarland, Recorder's Office, Lee County, Iowa, December 16, 1858.

Circa 1859 Abstract of conveyances of Lot 10 in Block 7, Illinoistown. Shows chain of title from 1817 to 1859.

Circa 1862 Abstract of conveyances of Lots 1 and 2 in Block 1 of Illinois Town. Shows chain of title from 1821 to 1862.

1862 Dec 20 Deed of sale of property in Keokuk, Iowa, from N.G. Hedges, sheriff of Lee County, Iowa, to J.E. and W.A. Yore. In a district court case, in which J.E. and W.A. Yore were plaintiffs, and John H. Hooper and George C. Dixon, executor of the estate of Robert Moore, deceased, were defendants, to foreclose a mortgage on the aforementioned property, the court ordered that the property should be sold to pay the amount of the judgment. **(filed oversized)**
